Lord, let your mercy be on us, as we place our trust in you! Our Lord Jesus is the fount of mercy and is pouring forth rays of mercy upon us. If you are alienated and ignored by others who ought to know better- offer mercy! If criticism and judgment is all you receive from others- offer mercy! The days of Mercy will end--- and then the days of Justice will reign! Do not let anything or anyone keep

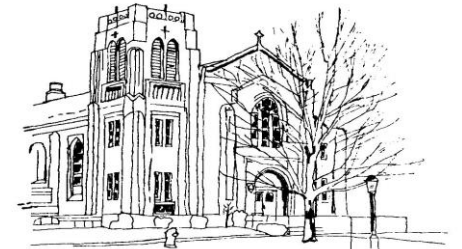
