HOLY CROSS FIRE UPDATE:

Sherry Geier and I met this past week with officials with Catholic Mutual (Insurance representative from Omaha Nebraska) The independent insurance adjustor (out of Vincennes Indiana) contracted by Catholic Mutual, another cost adjustor from Mobile Alabama (also connected to Catholic Mutual) and the onsite manager from Servpro. A forensic fire cause and point of origin inspector was also on site today. The exact cause of the fire will remain unknown, however, it appears to be in wiring that brought power to the organ console. This was located under the flooring in the choir loft. There would be no way for us to know the condition of the wire due to its location. We are still waiting for a structural engineer to perform an inspection to determine if there is loss of integrity to the walls, ceiling and roof of the church.

Servpro will continue its fire and smoke mitigation. Step one will begin tomorrow when Servpro will begin an inventory of all the items in the church and will begin to remove them for cleaning, repairs and storage. Step two (a start time has not been yet determined) will be the cleaning and repairs and any rebuilding of the church. PLEASE DO NOT ASK TO ENTER THE CHURCH FOR VIEWING. I will keep you informed as progress is made.


